

Yolo Federal Small Business Relief Grant \$5,000

Eligibility/Criteria

Open to any small business that is located in and serves Yolo County. Yolo FCU will reference the <u>Small Business Administration (SBA) table of size standards</u> to determine if the nominee is considered a small business. The business must nominate themselves.

- 1. Each nomination must include a completed, <u>online nomination</u> form with a compelling story (maximum of 500 words) that includes the following:
 - a. Explains what the business will do with the money.
 - b. How the money would help them during this time.
 - c. How it would give back to our local community.
- 2. Nominations will be done online at <u>yolofcu.org/small-business-relief-grant</u>. You can request a paper nomination form at (530) 668-2700 or at any branch location and the nominations must be mailed to:

- 3. All nominations must be submitted by May 25, 2020. Mail-in nominations must be postmarked May 25, 2020, to qualify.
- 4. Businesses owned by Credit Union employees and officials are not eligible to nominate their small business for the Relief Grant.
- 5. All nominations will go through a grant review process conducted by the Yolo FCU Marketing Department. The Marketing Department will then select the top 6 nominations with the most compelling stories and the ability to have the greatest impact on Yolo County. The top 6 nominations will be submitted to a public vote through the Yolo FCU website. The top two nominees, as voted on by the public, will each be awarded a \$5,000 Relief Grant.
- 6. Only 1 nomination per business will be accepted.
- 7. Only 1 vote per IP address will be accepted.
- 8. Awarded grantees will be announced via social media, in a press release in local publications, and on our website.
