Yolo Federal Credit Union Approved for WISH Grant Funds for Eligible Homebuyers

Yolo County, CA - Yolo Federal Credit Union announces that it has been approved to participate in the 2021 Workforce Initiative Subsidy for Homeownership (WISH) Program, where they can reserve funds for eligible homebuyers on a first-come, first-serve basis. The WISH Program grants funds to be distributed to first-time homebuyers within Yolo County. Yolo FCU has worked closely with the Cities of Woodland, Davis, West Sacramento, and Winters to identify and assist eligible individuals and families to access grant funds for down payment assistance.

The WISH Program provides grants to eligible homebuyers for up to \$22,000 in matching funds to be used for the down payment and closing costs involved with purchasing their home. Under the WISH Program, Yolo FCU will match up to \$4 for every dollar contributed by the homebuyer toward a home purchase.

“Our mission at Yolo FCU is to help Yolo County achieve financial success. Participating in this grant program is an important tool in helping us build upon our mission,” said Jenee Rawlings, President/CEO, Yolo Federal Credit Union. “We believe it is important to offer programs that provide low- and moderate-income individuals and families the opportunity to realize their dream of homeownership.”
