Yolo Federal Credit Union Donates Matching Funds up to \$5,000 for Big Day of Giving

Yolo County, CA: Yolo Federal Credit Union announced that they will be matching up to \$5,000 in donations to the Winters Healthcare Foundation for the Big Day of Giving. Winters Healthcare Foundation is a grassroots organization created in 2000 by a group of citizens who wanted to improve the health of all persons in the community. Winters Healthcare has become the primary healthcare provider for many community members and is committed to expanding services and accessibility. “One of our core values at Yolo Federal Credit Union is being committed to the prosperity of our community,” said Jenee Rawlings, Yolo Federal President/CEO. “We want to see Yolo County thrive. Donating to Winters Healthcare is a way for us to put our words into action.”

Winters Healthcare is raising funds to bridge the \$111,400 funding gap for an on-site Standby Emergency Generator to ensure power outages don’t disrupt their ability to provide healthcare services for the community. “We know Winters Healthcare needs another generator for their health center to ensure service continuity during times of failed power, most notably during fire season and extreme weather,” said Kelley Jacobsen, Yolo Federal VP-Marketing and Operations. “These critical resources are essential for them to continue serving the community without interruption.”

“Big Day of Giving provides us with more than just funding. It provides us with the opportunity to better serve our community with services that are integral to the health and well-being of those who would otherwise not have access to quality care,” said Lilly Steward, Winters Healthcare Marketing communications Coordinator/HR Generalist. “The funding we receive on this day allows us to invest in the health journeys of our neighbors for generations to come.”
